### The good news: Fewer teens having sex

A new report from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) shows a significant decline in teen sexual activity. The overall rate of high school students who have had sexual intercourse is down to 41 percent in 2015, from 47 percent in 2005 and 53 percent in 1995. Among ethnic groups, including black and Hispanic teens, the decrease is as much as 20 percent since 2005.

### The bad news: An epidemic of STIs

The CDC also estimates nearly 20 million new sexually transmitted infections (STIs) are reported each year, accounting for almost \$16 billion in health care costs annually. Close to *half* of all new cases occur in 15-to-25-year-olds, and a vast number of cases go unreported.

### The answer: YOU

Through the generosity of loyal donors who fund SHARE's annual budget, CPCI takes the powerful message of sexual abstinence outside of marriage to area teens through their churches, youth groups and private schools across Southwest Florida.
